Mark has the Gift of Encouragement and Helps, and he volunteered in the Chrysalis House in a multitude of ways, helping to keep the home running smoothly. Now, HOH has Mark and Kati volunteering in the Kitsap Jail, Thurs. evenings. Kati has been recently asked to work with the Women and teach a 5 week "InsideOut Program" (Re-entry Course), 3 days a week inside the Jail! This is a great blessing and we can look forward to the effect this team will have on our community at large...We hope that we will be able to open up a Chrysalis Transitional Home in the up and coming months. We believe it is the Lord's desire to provide a "safe-home" for ex-inmate women to change, grow in the Lord and live the life Christ designed them to live. Plus, the 30 hours of volunteer service in the Kitsap Jail weekly, as the Religious Coordinator (Chaplain). (HOH passes out over 100 bibles a month!!) *We always need MORE BIBLES!! PLEASE, help HOH in helping those in need! For years, fetal alcohol exposure was the leading known cause of intellectual disability in the Western world. In the <u>US</u> and <u>Europe</u>, the FAS Surveys found that in the US, 10–15% of pregnant women, report having recently drunk alcohol, and up to 30% drink alcohol at some point during pregnancy (Pregnant women are not uncommon in the Kitsap Co. Jail population). The current recommendation of the <u>Surgeon General of the US</u> and the <u>Department of Health</u> is to:

Drink NO alcohol (or take street drugs) at all during pregnancy!!
