A success story.....about N.C.

There was not a day in her life that she was not 'running'. Her mom died when she was young, and she did not have a 'dad' that she knew. Life was not fair or kind to her. She found herself locked in the cycle of gangs, using and selling drugs, going in and out of prison and jail, and leading a very dangerous and risk-filled life. What did she know? How could she have done anything different, given the circumstances? We met her right after she did time in solitary in Kitsap County Jail. As she heard us speak the Word, she started

trusting Jesus! She heard what He did for her on the cross, and she made a decision for Him! The time was coming close for her release from jail...and she was terrified of returning to her old 'hood'. At her request, HoH made some phone calls and set up a phone interview between her and the Seattle's Union Gospel Mission Hope Place. She was accepted and is now in their one-year recovery program.

She loves her new life and is loved by people who love Jesus!

Michael's Corner

Luke 2:41-52

In the story of Jesus, when He was twelve years old, His parents had been searching everywhere for three days. "Finding Him in the Temple of Jerusalem, ...Jesus was listening to the Rabbis, asking them questions..."

"All who heard Him were amazed at His understanding and His answers." (His mother was worried and confused): Mary says, "Your father and I have been anxiously looking for you"... Jesus replies to His mother, "Why, didn't you know that I had to be taking care of My Father's business?" Mary and Joseph did not understand Jesus at all!
